



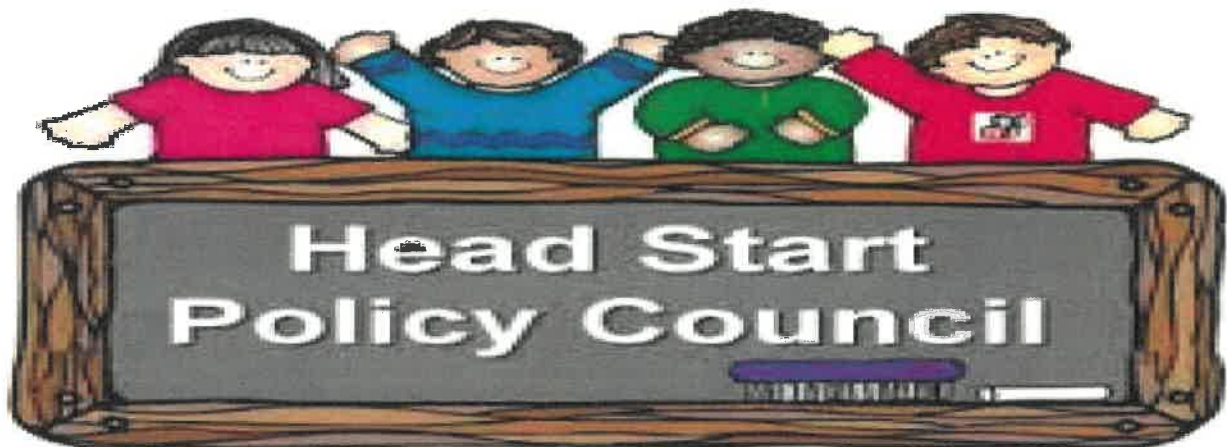

The responsibility for giving direction to the Head Start Program is shared by the Board of Directors, the Policy Council and the staff. The specific duties and responsibilities for the Policy Council are outlined in the Federal Regulations known as the Performance Standards. The Policy Council shares in the following responsibilities.

- Approve funding applications
- Review finances
- Planning
- Personnel actions
- Development of program policies
- Program Improvements
